
#### PTSA News...

#### April is Autism Awareness Month

Wear Blue and Celebrate World Autism Awareness Day on Saturday, April 2, 2022!!! Autism, or autism spectrum disorder (ASD), refers to a broad range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviors, speech and nonverbal communication. In 2021, the CDC reported that approximately 1 in 44 children in the U.S. is diagnosed with an autism spectrum disorder (ASD), according to 2018 data.

1 in 27 boys identified with autism 1 in 116 girls identified with autism

Boys are four times more likely to be diagnosed with autism than girls. Most children are still being diagnosed after age 4, though autism can be reliably diagnosed as early as age 2. Autism affects all ethnic and socioeconomic groups. Minority groups tend to be diagnosed later and less often. Early intervention affords the

best opportunity to support healthy development and deliver benefits across the lifespan through improved learning, communication and social skills, as well as underlying brain develop
